Advanced Micro Device CEO Dirk Meyer said Thursday company will deliver high-definition gaming and pictures to devices like smartphones in an attempt to bring more usability and interactivity to devices. To deliver content, AMD has announced that it will build a supercomputer that will games and movies. Technologies like HD gaming and movies will change the way content is created and how people will interact with smartphones and PCs, Meyer said during a speech at the Consumer Electronics Show in Las Vegas. The visual experience could also add more usability to the devices, Meyer said. People will only need a web browser on a smartphone and a decent broadband connection to access the supercomputer to instantly play games or watch Blu-ray movies, Meyer said. The supercomputer, which is called the Fusion Render Node, will change the way games and movies are delivered to mobile devices, Meyer said. It will deliver a petaflop of performance, matching other supercomputers and making it the fastest graphics supercomputer in the world, Meyer said. The Fusion Render Node also has a number of internal advantages over a supercomputer, Meyer said. It will consume one-tenth of the power of a supercomputer while it fits in a room, not halls like other supercomputers. The graphics supercomputer is essentially a rack of high-performance desktop ATI 4800 series graphics cards and Phenom II processors that are connected to each other and crunching tasks simultaneously. GPUs and CPUs will work in a coherent way, but petaflop performance is primarily based on the floating-point capabilities of GPUs, AMD spokesman John Taylor said. The system can be expanded by adding more toy supplies to the stand. At a stage presentation, Jules Urbach, founder and CEO of Otoy, presented several ATI graphics cards from several PCs working together to broadcast a first-person shooter game over a wired connection to a client device.
